ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE POLICIES

- 1. No employee will serve an alcoholic beverage to any person under the age of 21 years of age or any person who is visibly intoxicated.
- 2. In order to be served an alcoholic beverage, any guest who appears to be under 30 years of age is required to present legal identification that shows him or her to be 21 years of age or older.
- 3. Underage drinkers or persons passing alcoholic beverages to underage guests will be asked to leave.
- Central Standard staff will not, under any circumstances, knowingly serve alcohol to any person under 21 years of age, regardless of parental approval.
- 5. With the exception of wine and champagne, guests are not permitted to bring in their own alcoholic beverages under any circumstances. Central Standard, LLC reserves the right to remove anyone from the premises who are in violation of this policy. Central Standard, LLC also reserves the right to charge accordingly for any loss of revenue due to above listed infraction.
- Central Standard, LLC reserves the right to deny service to guests who display disruptive behavior and/or are considered to be intoxicated or otherwise impaired.
- 7. No staff member will knowingly serve several drinks to one guest during a short interval.
- 8. All staff members recognize that violations of our liquor license or any illegal drug activity will be grounds for immediate dismissal.
